Project Summary

Donut Dip partnered with Eversource to upgrade its interior and exterior lighting systems to energy efficient LEDs. Having the shop open every day, nearly around the clock, and lighting antique cases can be an expensive proposition particularly when it comes to energy costs. Now that the upgrade is complete, the shop's owners can expect to save more than \$1,400 in annual energy costs, while also providing better quality lighting for customers and employees.

Solution

Donut Dip took advantage of the Mass Save small business program to upgrade the shop's interior and exterior lighting to LEDs.
